

ECONOMETRICS AND QUANTITATIVE ECONOMICS

ECONOMETRICS AND QUANTITATIVE ECONOMICS ARE TWO CLOSELY INTERTWINED FIELDS THAT PLAY A VITAL ROLE IN UNDERSTANDING AND ANALYZING ECONOMIC PHENOMENA.
