TYPES OF UNEMPLOYMENT

FACTORS SUCH AS TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCEMENTS, CHANGES IN CONSUMER DEMAND, OR GLOBALIZATION CAN RENDER CERTAIN SKILLS OBSOLETE, LEADING TO JOB LOSSES IN SPECIFIC SECTORS. FRICTIONAL UNEMPLOYMENT

SEASONAL UNEMPLOYMENT

SEASONAL UNEMPLOYMENT AFFECTS INDUSTRIES THAT EXPERIENCE FLUCTUATIONS IN DEMAND BASED ON THE TIME OF YEAR, SUCH AS AGRICULTURE, TOURISM, AND RETAIL. WORKERS IN THESE SECTORS MAY BE EMPLOYED ONLY DURING PEAK SEASONS, LEADING TO PERIODS OF UNEMPLOYMENT DURING OFF-PEAK TIMES. UNDERSTANDING THIS TYPE OF UNEMPLOYMENT IS CRUCIAL FOR PLANNING AND MANAGING LABOR NEEDS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.

ECONOMIC IMPACTS OF UNEMPLOYMENT
