ENDOGENEITY CAN ARISE IN VARIOUS FORMS, INCLUDING SIMULTANEITY, OMITTED VARIABLE BIAS, AND MEASUREMENT ERROR. UNDERSTANDING THESE FORMS IS ESSENTIAL FOR ECONOMISTS AND RESEARCHERS TO APPRECIATE THE COMPLEXITIES INVOLVED IN CAUSAL INFERENCE AND THE INTERPRETATION OF THEIR RESULTS.

## TYPES OF ENDOGENEITY

THERE ARE THREE PRIMARY TYPES OF ENDOGENEITY THAT ECONOMISTS TYPICALLY ENCOUNTER:

- **MEASUREMENT ERROR:** WHEN THE INDEPENDENT VARIABLE IS MEASURED WITH ERROR, IT CAN CAUSE A CORRELATION WITH THE ERROR TERM, LEADING TO BIASED ESTIMATIONS.

## SOURCES OF ENDOGENEITY

THE SOURCES OF ENDOGENEITY CAN OFTEN BE TRACED BACK TO THE DESIGN OF THE STUDY OR THE DATA COLLECTION METHODS EMPLOYED. UNDERSTANDING THESE SOURCES IS CRITICAL FOR RESEARCHERS SEEKING TO MITIGATE THEIR EFFECTS. HERE ARE SOME COMMON SOURCES:

## DETECTING ENDOGENEITY
