

FEDERAL BUDGET ECONOMICS DEFINITION

FEDERAL BUDGET ECONOMICS DEFINITION REFERS TO THE SYSTEMATIC APPROACH TO UNDERSTANDING HOW A GOVERNMENT ALLOCATES ITS FINANCIAL RESOURCES THROUGH A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN KNOWN AS THE FEDERAL BUDGET.
