UNDERSTANDING SOFT VS. HARD SUBJECTS

- **METHODOLOGICAL RIGOR:** HARD SUBJECTS USUALLY EMPLOY STRICT METHODOLOGIES THAT YIELD REPRODUCIBLE RESULTS, WHEREAS SOFT SUBJECTS EMBRACE A RANGE OF METHODOLOGIES THAT CAN VARY SIGNIFICANTLY.

THE NATURE OF ECONOMICS

ECONOMICS STRADDLES THE LINE BETWEEN SOFT AND HARD SUBJECTS, INCORPORATING ELEMENTS OF BOTH. IT USES MATHEMATICAL MODELS AND STATISTICAL TOOLS TO ANALYZE ECONOMIC PHENOMENA, WHICH CAN SUGGEST A HARD SCIENCE CLASSIFICATION. MICROECONOMICS: THE INDIVIDUAL AND THE MARKET
