THE UMD ECONOMICS MAJOR IS DESIGNED TO PROVIDE STUDENTS WITH A ROBUST UNDERSTANDING OF ECONOMIC THEORY AND PRACTICE. THIS MAJOR ATTRACTS A DIVERSE GROUP OF STUDENTS, RANGING FROM THOSE INTERESTED IN PUBLIC POLICY TO THOSE AIMING FOR CAREERS IN FINANCE. WITH A MIX OF THEORETICAL KNOWLEDGE AND PRACTICAL APPLICATION, THE UMD ECONOMICS PROGRAM PREPARES GRADUATES TO TACKLE REAL-WORLD ECONOMIC ISSUES EFFECTIVELY.

CURRICULUM DETAILS

THE CURRICULUM FOR THE UMD ECONOMICS MAJOR IS STRUCTURED TO PROVIDE A SOLID FOUNDATION IN ECONOMIC PRINCIPLES WHILE ALLOWING STUDENTS TO EXPLORE SPECIALIZED AREAS OF INTEREST. STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE CORE COURSES THAT COVER MICROECONOMICS, MACROECONOMICS, AND ECONOMETRICS. IN ADDITION TO CORE COURSES, STUDENTS HAVE THE FLEXIBILITY TO CHOOSE ELECTIVES THAT ALIGN WITH THEIR CAREER GOALS.

CORE COURSES

THE CORE COURSES IN THE UMD ECONOMICS PROGRAM INCLUDE:

- **PRINCIPLES OF MICROECONOMICS:** THIS COURSE INTRODUCES STUDENTS TO THE DECISION-MAKING PROCESSES OF INDIVIDUALS AND FIRMS AND HOW THESE DECISIONS INFLUENCE MARKET OUTCOMES.
- **PRINCIPLES OF MACROECONOMICS:** STUDENTS LEARN ABOUT THE ECONOMY AS A WHOLE, EXPLORING TOPICS SUCH AS INFLATION, UNEMPLOYMENT, AND ECONOMIC GROWTH.

- **ECONOMETRICS:** THIS COURSE EQUIPS STUDENTS WITH STATISTICAL METHODS USED TO ANALYZE ECONOMIC DATA AND TEST HYPOTHESES.

ELECTIVE COURSES

IN ADDITION TO CORE COURSES, STUDENTS CAN SELECT FROM A VARIETY OF ELECTIVE COURSES THAT MAY INCLUDE:

- **INTERNATIONAL ECONOMICS:** FOCUSES ON TRADE THEORY AND POLICIES AFFECTING GLOBAL MARKETS.
- **LABOR ECONOMICS:** EXAMINES LABOR MARKETS, WAGE DETERMINATION, AND EMPLOYMENT ISSUES.
- **DEVELOPMENT ECONOMICS:** LOOKS AT ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND THE CHALLENGES FACED BY DEVELOPING COUNTRIES.
