DEFINING M2

M2 IS A BROADER MEASURE OF THE MONEY SUPPLY THAT INCLUDES ALL OF M1 PLUS ADDITIONAL FORMS OF MONEY THAT ARE LESS LIQUID. M2 ENCOMPASSES SAVINGS ACCOUNTS, TIME DEPOSITS, AND OTHER NEAR-MONEY ASSETS THAT CAN BE CONVERTED INTO CASH RELATIVELY EASILY. THE COMPONENTS OF M2 INCLUDE:

- **M1:** ALL THE COMPONENTS OF M1 ARE INCLUDED IN M2.
- **SAVINGS ACCOUNTS:** THESE ARE BANK ACCOUNTS THAT EARN INTEREST BUT ARE NOT AS READILY ACCESSIBLE AS DEMAND DEPOSITS.
- **TIME DEPOSITS:** THESE INCLUDE FIXED-TERM DEPOSITS THAT CANNOT BE WITHDRAWN WITHOUT A PENALTY UNTIL THE TERM EXPIRES, SUCH AS CERTIFICATES OF DEPOSIT (CDs).
