UNDERSTANDING THE BASICS OF DOMAIN

IN MATHEMATICAL TERMS, THE DOMAIN CAN BE EXPRESSED IN VARIOUS FORMS, SUCH AS INTERVALS, SETS, OR INEQUALITIES. IT'S ALSO IMPORTANT TO RECOGNIZE THAT DIFFERENT TYPES OF FUNCTIONS MAY HAVE DIFFERENT DOMAINS BASED ON THEIR ALGEBRAIC STRUCTURE. FIND EXCLUDED VALUES.

- **RADICAL FUNCTIONS:** FOR FUNCTIONS THAT INCLUDE A SQUARE ROOT OR AN EVEN ROOT, LIKE $f(x) = \sqrt[n]{g(x)}$, THE DOMAIN CONSISTS OF ALL VALUES FOR WHICH $g(x) \geq 0$.
- **LOGARITHMIC FUNCTIONS:** THE DOMAIN OF A LOGARITHMIC FUNCTION, SUCH AS $f(x) = \log_b(x)$, IS THE SET OF ALL POSITIVE REAL NUMBERS ($x > 0$).

3. EXPRESS THE DOMAIN USING INTERVAL NOTATION, EXCLUDING THE IDENTIFIED VALUES.

FOR EXAMPLE, CONSIDER THE FUNCTION $f(x) = 1/(x - 3)$. TO FIND THE DOMAIN, WE SET THE DENOMINATOR $x - 3 = 0$, WHICH GIVES US $x = 3$. THUS, THE DOMAIN IS ALL REAL NUMBERS EXCEPT 3, EXPRESSED AS $(-\infty, 3) \cup (3, \infty)$.

FINDING THE DOMAIN OF RADICAL FUNCTIONS

FOR RADICAL FUNCTIONS, THE APPROACH INVOLVES ENSURING THAT THE EXPRESSION UNDER THE RADICAL IS NON-NEGATIVE. HERE'S HOW TO FIND THE DOMAIN:

1. IDENTIFY THE RADICAL FUNCTION, FOR INSTANCE, $f(x) = \sqrt{x + 4}$.
2. SET THE EXPRESSION INSIDE THE RADICAL GREATER THAN OR EQUAL TO ZERO: $x + 4 \geq 0$.
3. SOLVE THE INEQUALITY: $x \geq -4$. THE DOMAIN IS THEN EXPRESSED AS $[-4, \infty)$.

COMMON MISTAKES IN DOMAIN CALCULATION
