- **DRAG-AND-DROP QUESTIONS:** THESE INVOLVE MATCHING CONCEPTS OR ARRANGING ITEMS IN THE CORRECT ORDER TO SOLVE A PROBLEM.

EACH OF THESE QUESTION TYPES REQUIRES DIFFERENT STRATEGIES FOR SUCCESS, AND PRACTICE IS KEY TO MASTERING THEM. BY FAMILIARIZING YOURSELF WITH THESE FORMATS, YOU CAN INCREASE YOUR COMFORT LEVEL AND REDUCE TEST ANXIETY.

COMMON MATH CONCEPTS ON THE GED

BY FOCUSING YOUR STUDY EFFORTS ON THESE KEY AREAS, YOU CAN BUILD A SOLID FOUNDATION FOR THE TYPES OF QUESTIONS YOU'LL ENCOUNTER ON THE TEST. MAKE SURE TO PRACTICE PROBLEMS IN EACH CATEGORY TO ENSURE A WELL-ROUNDED UNDERSTANDING.

STRATEGIES FOR ANSWERING GED MATH QUESTIONS

- **PRACTICE TIME MANAGEMENT:** KEEP TRACK OF THE TIME DURING THE TEST. ALLOCATE YOUR TIME BASED ON THE NUMBER OF QUESTIONS, ENSURING YOU HAVE TIME FOR ALL.

SAMPLE GED MATH QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

$$3x = 15$$

NOW, DIVIDE BY 3:

$$x = 5$$

QUESTION 2:

WHAT IS THE AREA OF A RECTANGLE WITH A LENGTH OF 10 CM AND A WIDTH OF 4 CM?

ANSWER: THE AREA A OF A RECTANGLE IS CALCULATED AS:

$$A = \text{LENGTH} \times \text{WIDTH}$$

$$A = 10 \text{ cm} \times 4 \text{ cm} = 40 \text{ cm}^2$$

QUESTION 3:

WHAT IS THE MEAN OF THE FOLLOWING SET OF NUMBERS: 5, 10, 15, 20?

ANSWER: TO FIND THE MEAN, ADD THE NUMBERS AND DIVIDE BY THE COUNT:

$$(5 + 10 + 15 + 20) / 4 = 50 / 4 = 12.5$$

PREPARING FOR THE GED MATH TEST
