HEATING LOAD CALCULATION

THIS FACTOR CAN DEPEND ON INSULATION QUALITY, LOCAL CLIMATE, AND BUILDING MATERIALS.

DUCT SIZE CALCULATION

$$\text{DUCT SIZE (INCHES)} = (\text{CFM} \times 0.1) / (\text{VELOCITY IN FPM})$$
